

Help Your Student Get Started with Outstanda

Outstanda is a nonprofit helping measure student's literacy, math, and critical thinking progress weekly and sharing the information with parents and teachers.

Step 1: Why Your Student Needs Email

- Every student must have a personal email address to use Outstanda.
- If your child already has an email, you can skip to Section 2.
- If not, you must set one up.

Easy Free Email Choices:

- **Gmail (Google)** – works best with phones and most apps.
- **Outlook (Microsoft)** – another good choice.

👉 Ask a friend, family member, or teacher for help if you need assistance.

Step 2: If Your Student is Under 13 Years Old

- Parents must create the Outstanda account.
- Steps:
 1. Go to hub.outstanda.org
 2. Create your own account. Confirm email via link.
 3. From the menu, open the parent page.
 4. Add your student's information.



Step 3: If Your Student is 13–17 Years Old

- Parent may choose to create the account, **or**
- Students may create their own account.

Either way: Students need access to their email to get a login link.

Step 4: Logging In and Adding Classes

- Once account is ready:
 1. Student logs into Outstanda using the link sent to their email.
 2. Instructors give class codes.
 3. Student adds the classes with the codes.
